THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BONNECHERE VALLEY

BY-LAW NO. 2020-049

BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES ON MUNICIPAL HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF BONNECHERE VALLEY

WHEREAS the Highway Traffic Act, Section 191.8, subsection (3), as amended, provides that the Council of a Municipality may pass by-laws permitting the operation of All Terrain Vehicles on any highway within the Municipality that are under the jurisdiction of the Municipality or any part or parts of such highways;

And Whereas as of July 1st, 2020 extreme terrain vehicles and off-road motorcycles can also be specifically permitted by the municipality on any highway within the Municipality that is under the jurisdiction of the Municipality or any par or parts of such highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Bonnechere Valley deems it in the best public interest to regulate the operation of All Terrain Vehicles including extreme terrain and off-road motorcycles within the Municipality.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BONNECHERE VALLEY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Notwithstanding any other by-law to the contrary, the operation of All Terrain Vehicles including extreme terrain and off-road motorcycles shall be permitted on all highways under the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the Township of Bonnechere Valley.
- 2. All of the provisions of Ontario Regulation 316/03, Operation of Off-Road Vehicles on Highways, as amended, shall apply to this by-law.
- 3. Any person who contravenes any section of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in The Provincial Offences Act.
- 4. By-Law 2004-13 and By-Law 2015-039 are hereby repealed.
- 5. This By-Law shall come into force and take effect on the day of its passing and shall remain in effect until otherwise amended or repealed.
