

**THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF BONNECHERE VALLEY
BY-LAW NO. 2015-005**

**BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR EXEMPTION
FROM TAXATION OF THE TOWNSHIP PORTION
OF THE MUNICIPAL TAXES FOR THE ROYAL
CANADIAN LEGION BRANCH 353**

WHEREAS pursuant to the Assessment Act, R.S.O. 1990 Chapter A 131, Section 6, land that is used and occupied as a memorial home, clubhouse or athletic grounds by persons who served in the armed forces of His or Her Majesty or an ally of His or Her Majesty in any war is exempted from taxation in the circumstances and to the extent described in the section; and

WHEREAS the Council of a Municipality may pass by-laws exempting from taxation, other than school taxes and local improvement rates, land described in subsection (1) on such conditions as may be set out in the by-laws; and

WHEREAS an exemption under subsection (2) must not exceed 10 years but may be renewed at any time during the last year of the exemption; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Bonnechere Valley deems it advisable to enact a By-law pursuant to section 6 of the Assessment Act to exempt the municipal (lower tier) portion of the taxes for the Royal Canadian Legion, Eganville Branch No. 353.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township Bonnechere Valley enacts as follows:

1. THAT the lands and premises of the Royal Canadian Legion Eganville Branch 353 which are used and occupied as a club house by persons who served in the Armed Forces of Her Majesty or Her Majesty's allies in any war be exempt from taxation for the Township portion of the municipal taxes except for local improvements and school purposes for the 2015, 2016, 2017 2018 taxation years.
2. THAT this by-law shall be deemed to have come into force and effect January 1, 2015.
