All residents may use ANY of the Township Waste Facilities to recycle your materials and dispose of your waste. We have services to enable you to bring your organics to each site for composting. Please recycle and compost as much as possible. Bulky waste and construction/demolition materials must be taken to Sno Drifters and any remaining waste can be take to the site of your choice.

The curbside collection schedule for Village Residents is available on our website or a hardcopy can be obtained at the Municipa Office. Garbage tags must be purchased and placed on all bags placed at curbside for collection. The cost per tag is \$2. Pick-up for recycling is every Tuesday (each week is different as to what is picked up) and garbage pick-up is on Thursdays. Please have it out by the curb by 7 am.

When you receive your March Tax Bill there is a FREE VOUCHER for use at the Sno Drifters site exclusively. The FREE Vouchers are only included with the March Bills and is only given out to properties that have a dwelling or building on them. VACANT parcels of land do not receive the free voucher as they do not accumulate bulky items, construction or demolition materials. The voucher permits up to 550 kg's for FREE. If your load weighs over this amount then you will be responsible to pathe amount over and above this weight in cash.



- · Flowers, plants and weeds
- · Dried flowers
- Leaves
- Grass clippings
- Branches (<12mm diameter &</li>
   <1.5 m length)</li>
- · Pumpkins
- Houseplants, including soil
- · Twigs and hedge trimmings
- Wooden popsicle stikes
- Untreated wood chips & sawdust
- Untreated wood scraps (<75 mm)</li>
- Straw and hay






Sno Drifters Waste Site - 213 Sno Drifters Road




Hwy 41 Transfer Site - 1002 Larmond Road




Sand Road Landfill Site -957 Sand Road
