

TOWNSHIP OF BONNECHERE VALLEY
HIGH WATER EVENT 2017 - DEBRIS MANAGEMENT PLAN

1. Sand

- ❖ Public Notification on website and newspaper ad
 - a. County Health Unit and MNRF do not recommend emptying sandbags onto your beach or places where children play because of possible contamination of the sand from the flood waters.
 - b. The Township will pick up unwanted sandbags on one weekend near the end of June. Date to be announced.
 - c. On the pickup date – unwanted sandbags are to be placed in a convenient location near the end of you driveway.
 - d. Residents wishing sand bags to be picked up are to contact the Emergency Management Coordinator prior June 23, 2017. Sands would be picked up on June 24, 2017 and June 25, 2017.

2. Washed Up Debris

- ❖ Public Notification on website and newspaper ad
 - a. Debris washed up onto the shoreline or debris from flooded areas of the property (basements, sheds etc) may be brought to the Ruby Road Waste Site or the Sno Drifters Waste site during normal operating hours.
 - b. The Waste Site managers have been instructed that if it is flood related debris that it will be accepted at no charge. Names and addresses of where the debris originated will be recorded at the time of drop off and identification may be requested to ensure only Bonnechere Valley residents make use of this offer.
 - c. For those residents requiring help with the transportation of debris due to age or disability please call the Emergency Management Coordinator and an appointment will be set for either July 8, 2017 or July 9, 2017.

3. Household Hazardous Waste

- ❖ Public Notification on website and newspaper ad
 - a. Household Hazardous Waste to be brought to the Sand Road HHW site by residents. During normal operating hours.
 - b. Residents to be reminded to be careful not to mix HHW in with other debris.
 - c. Gas Cans, Propane bottles etc are considered as HHW
 - d. No pickup will be offered.

4. Woody Vegetation.

- a. Woody Vegetation may be brought to any of the waste sites by residents at no charge.
- b. No pick up will be offered.
