Re: RV use on Lake Clear

Dear Mayor Murphy and Municipal Councillors:

We are long time Lake Clear property owners. My parents purchased the property in the mid 60's and my husband and I bought it from them in the early 90's. We have long enjoyed this wonderful lake and all that it has to offer.

We just recently put in a new and approved septic system. We have maintained a buffer zone at the water's edge, have planted other vegetation to prevent erosion and are staunch supporters of protecting Lake Clear.

We are very concerned about the increase in the number of trailers on Lake Clear and ask the BVT to pass a by-law which addresses where RVs may be placed on a lot (same rules as cottages and other buildings), how many RVs may be placed on a lot (same restrictions as cottages, sleep cabins and garden suites), waste disposal requirements and taxation. It is totally unfair that while we pay more taxes for every legal dwelling, they don't contribute at all, yet they certainly reap the benefits of the services that we fund. They need to be regulated the same way that cottages are.
