COPKA has two members interested in volunteering for the Policing for Results Survey - Georgia Steffan and Genevieve Jones. Sgt. Luckasavitch got both of their phone numbers. The survey will be led by OPP Cadet, Melissa Laundry. Those conducting the survey will be volunteers, not OPP officers. The survey will take place over the next three months.

Brian Tyrrell questioned whether there was any public input on the local questions. Sgt. Luckasavitch told him that yes there was, however the local questions for this year have already been chosen.

The committee watched two video presentations on the Community Policing for Results Survey. The main purpose of the survey is to determine the quality of policing services in the community. In 2004 there were 375 people surveyed.

6. 2007 Budget

The committee discussed their budgetary needs for 2007. There is approximately \$1100 in the CPAC bank account.

The discussion is tabled to the next meeting in March.

7. Police Report - Sgt. Darren Luckasavitch

Cst. Mike Hartwick will transfer to Renfrew Detachment effective April 23, 2007.

Detective Constable Colin Reinke will transfer to East Region Community Response team on February 26, 2007. A competition for the vacant Detective Constable position was held on February 15, Cst. Sue Norris Macinnis was the successful candidate. She commences her new duties on February 26, 2007.

Two recruits, Keltie Milloy and Jason Hamilton will be reporting to Killaloe on April 30, 2007. S/Sgt. Jim Graham will retire effective July 31, 2007.

Sgts. Mackisoc, Luckasavitch and Sears completed Basic Emergency Management training from Feb 20-22, 2007. Sgt. Luckasavitch will receive emergency Site Management training from March 05-09, 2007. Sgt. Guty and S/Sgt. Graham have basic, ESM, and EOC management courses.

Policing for Results Survey will take place in the upcoming months. It will be advertised in the media to alleviate any concerns from the public. Those conducting the survey will be volunteers, not OPP officers. Jim requested that if you know anyone that would be willing to assist, please let him know. The last survey took place in February - April 2004.

Randy Jessup questioned whether the number of animal collisions on the Highway, especially deer, were ever reported to the MNR. The answer is no. If the MNR wants that information they can access it through the MTO. The traffic reports that the O.P.P. submit to the MTO include that information. Mr. Jessup felt that the MNR could use this

information to set larger hunting limits.
