7. Garbage

Merv brought up the issue of garbage along the roadside. It is a major problem along the

Ruby Road, along the bush line. Stan also brought up the garbage issue along Simpson Pit Road. S/Sgt. Jim Graham told the members that the OPP will work with the by-law enforcement officers in each township in regards to this problem, but they need to have evidence. Kevin informed the committee that North Algona Wilberforce passes a by-law in regards to littering along the roads.

2007 Budget

The committee discussed their budgetary needs for 2007. Then tabled the discussion to the next meeting in February.

8. Police Report - S/Sgt. Jim Graham

Merv questioned the statistics on the Provincial Highways. S/Sgt. Graham confirmed that they are not charged back against the township unless, the incident occurred on the connecting link.

Cst. Mike Hartwick will transfer to Renfrew Detachment effective April 23, 2007. Two recruits, Keltie Milloy and Jason Hamilton will be reporting to Killaloe on April 30, 2007. S/Sgt. Jim Graham will retire effective July 31, 2007.

Jim distributed the quarterly reports to the committee. Jim also included the stats for 'calls for service' for Nov 2005 to Nov 2006 and Dec 2005 to Dec 2006

The Festive Ride Program ran from November 29, 2006 to January 2, 2007. Members set up 98 RIDE initiatives throughout the detachment area.

4128 vehicles checked

4 12 hr suspensions

6 Persons charged impaired, over 80 or refusal

36 Other charges laid (*Criminal Code, Highway Traffic Act, Liquor License Act, etc.*)

Sgts. Mackisoc, Luckasavitch and Sears will receive basic Emergency Management training from Feb 20-22, 2007. Sgt. Luckasavitch will receive emergency Site Management training from March 05-09, 2007. Sgt. Guty and S/Sgt. Graham have basic, ESM, and EOC management courses.

Policing for Results Survey will be taking place again in the upcoming months. It will be well advertised in the media to alleviate any concerns from the public. The survey will be lead by OPP Cadet, Melissa Laundry. Those conducting the survey will be volunteers, not OPP officers. Jim requested that if you know anyone that would be willing to assist, please let him know. The last survey took place in February - April 2004.
