Regular Meeting - Thursday June 28, 2007

1. Chair, Stanley Pecoskie called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m.
2. Confirmation of the agenda.
3. Approval of the minutes of May 24, 2007.

4. Correspondence - none.
5. Delegations - Brian Tyrrell, COPKA
Brian addressed the committee, and informed them that he has been told by observers in both Wilno and Barry's Bay that cruiser speeds are down.
6. Business
 - a) Merv informed the committee that Bonnechere Valley township has reduced the speed limit on O'Connor Road from 80 km/hr down to 60 km/hr.
 - b) Randy noted that the open house for the Ambulance Service will be July 14 at 11:00 am.
 - c) Randy questioned how police checks work with students or volunteers that wish to do jobs for individuals. Sgt. Darren Luckasavitch informed him that some places require this because of confidentiality reasons or the people will be dealing with money. When an individual requests a police check it is free if they require it for volunteer work.
 - d) Merv informed the committee that the "Rainbow Valley Health Unit" will be

- having a yard sale at Hoch Farm on June 30th.
- e) Merv also said they are having a fundraiser on July 28, 2007 at 7:30 pm at Station Park in Killaloe, youth bands will kick off the event with the main show being "McMillan RoadKill".
 - f) Kevin informed the committee that there will be horseshoes on July 7th and August 25th at the Eganville Sno-Drifters Clubhouse. There is a fishing derby sponsored by the North Algona Wilberforce Fire Department on Lake Dore.
 - g) Kevin also questioned whether the O.P.P. can pick up CB radios, specifically Channel 9. Sgt. Darren Luckasavitch said at one time they were able to monitor this channel but with their new technology they are no longer capable of this.
 - h) Stanley noted that some speed limit signs in the area are being reported as missing and that some 911 signs are bent over as well. This is not only costly but can be dangerous as well for emergency services. They are also having problems with a sign at the boat launch.
 - i) Sylvie noted that three youths were caught at the water tower hill drinking and smoking. Some of the parents would like to get more involved, therefore a meeting is scheduled with Sgt. Darren Luckasavitch on June 29, 2007 at 9:00 am.
 - j) Kevin questioned whether there has been any action near the Golden Lake Municipal Yard and Sgt. Darren Luckasavitch told him that officers have been watching the area very closely.

7. Police Report - Sgt. Darren Luckasavitch

One member is on maternity leave, anticipated date of return is May 18, 2008. A second member will be commencing maternity leave on September 23, 2007 anticipated date of return is September 21, 2008.

S/Sgt. Jim Graham will retire effective July 31, 2007. Sgt. Darren Luckasavitch will then become Acting Detachment Commander until a permanent replacement is selected. A competition is now underway. Constable Keith Gill will then be Acting Sgt. on Sgt. Luckasavitch's platoon. Recruit Christopher Throop will be reporting to Killaloe at the end of August, 2007.
