2. Confirmation of the agenda.
3. Approval of the minutes of June 28, 2007.

6. Business

Kevin brought forth an issue that had been brought to NAW Council. Every time there is an emergency situation their roads superintendent, gets called out even if it is not in his jurisdiction. It may be a county road or a provincial road. He was wondering if dispatch had the wrong contact number. Their roads superintendent has no problem being called out when it is an issue with one of NAW roads. Darren said if he could get an exact time and date that the call was made to the roads superintendent he could track the incident and see exactly what the chain of command was.

Sylvie said that in Madawaska Valley their township would go ahead and respond to the issue even if it was not under their jurisdiction but was in their township to avoid the possibility of a larger issue occurring.

Merv recommended that Darren meet with our fire chief to discuss emergency plans etc. Merv also brought up the issue of fire extraction calls. The township only gets paid if they actually preform the extraction however if they are on route and get called off while on route they do not get paid for the call.

The committee discussed Renfrew County ATV group. The OPP will be enforcing any violations on this trail. Madawaska Valley owns their railway bed and they have signed an agreement with Renfrew County ATV. Local residents are exempt from paying for a pass. They must go into the township office with their ATV vehicle ownership and proof of insurance and they get a pass for the 6 months.

Merv brought up the issue of vandalism and graffiti in Centennial Park in the Village of Eganville. They are in the process of getting the park cleaned up and he would like the police to keep on eye on it. They need to get their camera technology in the park updated.

Stanley got a call from a tow truck operator complaining that it was obvious that one particular towing company seems to get all the business from the OPP. He questioned Darren as to whose discretion it is when a tow is needed - the officer or the individual who owns the vehicle. The vehicle owner can call who he/she likes to tow the vehicle as long as it can be there within a reasonable amount of time.

The gentleman that called Stanley was on the scene of an accident, awaiting for the OPP to arrive on scene when this other tow company showed up. This gentleman that called Stanley will be coming in to speak with Darren.

The committee discussed the attendance of delegations for the duration of the entire CPAC meeting. The committee felt that delegates should only be present for the duration of their business.
