

**THE CORPORATION OF THE
MUNICIPALITY OF BONNECHERE VALLEY**

BY-LAW 2001-34

**BEING A BY-LAW TO CHANGE THE NAME OF
THE MUNICIPALITY FROM MUNICIPALITY OF
BONNECHERE VALLEY TO TOWNSHIP OF
BONNECHERE VALLEY**

WHEREAS A Minister's Restructuring Order provides that on January 1, 2001, the inhabitants of the municipal area, comprising of the former Township of Grattan, former Township of Sebastopol, the former Township of South Algona and the former Village of Eganville are constituted as body corporate under the name, "Municipality of Bonnechere Valley".

AND WHEREAS Section 12.1 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45 as amended provides that a municipality may by by-law change its name so long as the new name is not the same as the name of another municipality;

AND WHEREAS, Public Notice has been given in the local newspaper of Council's intention to pass a by-law to change the name of the municipal corporation from **Municipality** of Bonnechere Valley to **Township** of Bonnechere Valley in accordance with the requirements of Section 12.1(2) of the Municipal Act.

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE
MUNICIPALITY OF BONNECHERE VALLEY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the name of the municipality is hereby changed from "The Corporation of the **Municipality** of Bonnechere Valley" to "The Corporation of the **Township** of Bonnechere Valley".
2. That in accordance with the requirements of the said Municipal Act, a copy of this by-law shall be forwarded to the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing and the Director of Titles appointed under the Land Titles Act.
3. This By-Law comes into force on the date of final passage hereof.

PUBLIC NOTICE

PROPOSED BY-LAW TO CHANGE THE MUNICIPAL NAME

TAKE NOTICE that A Minister's Restructuring Order provides that on January 1, 2001, the inhabitants of the municipal area, comprising of the former Township of Grattan, former Township of Sebastopol, the former Township of South Algona and the former Village of Eganville are constituted as a body corporate under the name, "Municipality of Bonnechere Valley",

AND THAT, a subsequent amendment to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45, as amended, with the enactment of Bill 119, provides that a municipality may by by-law change its name so long as the new name of the new municipality is not the same as the name of another municipality;

AND THAT, the Transition Board representing the former municipalities of the Township of Grattan, Township of Sebastopol, Township of South Algona and the Village of Eganville, by resolution, supported changing the name of the new municipality to "**Township** of Bonnechere Valley";

AND FURTHER THAT, the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Bonnechere Valley passed a resolution at its meeting on February 19, 2001 approving the change of the name to "**Township** of Bonnechere Valley" and directing the Clerk to give the required notice to the public.

THEREFORE, PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given to all residents within the Municipality of Bonnechere Valley that the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Bonnechere Valley proposes to enact a By-Law to change the name from the **Municipality** of Bonnechere Valley to **Township** of Bonnechere Valley at its regular meeting on Monday, March 19, 2001.
