

What you need to know about safety in your short-term rentals

Check with your municipality about their short-term rentals policy. Short-term rentals are not permitted in all areas. Some municipalities will require inspections of the unit and a fee for a license.

- Make sure you get all approvals before operating a short-term rental. This gives your renters added piece of mind to know they're renting a safe, municipal-approved short-term rental.
- Get an inspection before renting out your short-term rental. A building official will check your exits, smoke alarms and make sure your rental meets all requirements for safety.

Municipally approved short-term rentals are typically inspected for life safety compliance.
