Waste Sites - Summer Hours Schedule

All residents may use ANY of the Township Waste/Transfer Sites to recycle your materials and dispose of your waste. Bulky Waste and Construction materials must be taken to **Sno Drifters**. The Sno Drifters site can be opened on a call-in basis as long as staff are in the area for an opening fee. **Please note: Summer hours in the schedule below start on May 23, 2023 until Thanksgiving Weekend, 2023. The Hazardous Waste Depot at Sand Road Waste Site will also be open Saturdays ONLY May 27, 2023 until September 30, 2023. However, the Sno Drifters site will begin Mondays to Thursdays beginning Tuesday May 23, 2023 to Thursday August 31, 2023. We now accept tires at the Sno Drifters site with or without rims.**
