GRAVEL ROADS

With the changing of the seasons, gravel roads are highly susceptible to pot holing, rutting, frost heaving and in some cases, water on the road. Gravel road maintenance is challenging during the spring thaw. Maintenance windows are limited due to the fluctuating temperatures and weather patterns. During this transitional period, grading can only be conducted when the road surface is firm, otherwise when gravel is moved, more mud is created. If more material were to be added to the roads and graders were used prior to these ideal conditions, gravel road surfaces would lose integrity, leading to increased damage and unsafe road conditions. Please be patient and drive carefully. Public Works is doing their best to ensure the safest driving conditions possible given these circumstances.
