# Shop Local Program - Rural Rewards

A new collaborative initiative has been launched with six participating municipalities. The Townships of Brudenell, Lyndoch Raglan, Killaloe, Hagarty & Richards, Bonnechere Valley, North Algona Wilberforce, Madawaska Valley and Whitewater Region have partnered to promote local businesses by encouraging residents to shop local.

The program is called the "Rural Rewards" and will consist of the distribution of Rural Rewards Cards (pickup in the participating businesses or at the municipal offices) that can be stamped or initialed by a store clerk after making a purchase at any of the businesses within the participating municipalities.

After 10 completed purchases, the Rural Rewards Cards can be dropped off at your municipal office and a new card picked-up. Each Township will have a monthly draw (draws occur after the 15th of every month) for a \$25 local gift card/certificate of the winners choosing from one of the participating businesses. The campaign will run from June 14, 2021 till December 15, 2021.

## **New Protocol for Fire Permits**

All open air fire excluding campfires, require a permit all year round. During the Provincial fire season (April 1st to October 21st), permit fires shall not be started prior to 2 hours before sunset and must be extinguished prior to 2 hours after sunrise. Fire Permits can be obtained at the municipal office or via our website at www.bonnecherevalleytwp.com/departments/firedepartment/open-air-burns/.

#### Please "BE ADVISED THAT 24 HOUR NOTICE IS RE-QUIRED BEFORE PERMIT APPROVAL TO ALLOW THE FIRE DEPARTMENT TO VISIT PROPOSED BURN SITES".

The Fire Permit is NOT VALID until the fire department is contacted and a site inspection is performed, then they will validate this permit. They can be contacted at fire@eganville.com or 613.312.7361.
