

Remote Rural Mental Health & Addiction Initiative

The Township of Bonnechere Valley is pleased to share information with you regarding a new initiative that was formed at the beginning of January 2021 called the "Remote Rural Mental Health & Addiction Initiative (RRMHAI). It was formed to explore the provision of methods of mental health and addiction care in the remote and rural communities along the Highway 60 corridor of Renfrew County and the Whitewater Bromley regions. The initiative recognizes the role technology plays in reaching as many individuals as possible and strives to identify the virtual care requirements of those needing mental health and addiction care and connecting them to existing resources.

In the coming months, the primary goal of the community will be to create community hubs in which individuals can privately access a variety of established mental health and addiction resources. Most people forego mental health and addiction care because they do not know where to go to get help or not being able to afford to pay for it. The hope is that these hubs will begin to erode these barriers.

The committee is supported through The Phoenix Center, ConnectWell Community Health, The Rotary Club of Eganville, West Champlain Family Health Team, the Township of Bonnechere Valley, Family and Children Services of Renfrew County, Renfrew Victoria Hospital Addictions Treatment Service, Pembroke Regional Hospital Mental Health Service Renfrew County and Algonquin College Community Employment Services.

Waste Site Summer Hours Schedule

All residents may use ANY of the Township Wastes/Transfer Sites to recycle your materials and dispose of your waste. Bulky Waste and Construction materials must be taken to <u>Sno Drifters</u>. The Sno Drifters site can be opened on a callin basis as long as staff are in the area. This will result in an opening fee plus the cost of your weighted load. This site accepts cash only. Included in the March Tax bill was a FREE Voucher for use at the Sno Drifters Site exclusively. This voucher permits up to 550 kg's for FREE. If your load weighs over this amount then you will be responsible to pay the amount over and above this weight. The FREE Voucher was only given out to properties which have a dwelling or building on the them. We no longer give Vacant parcels of land free vouchers as they do not accumulate bulky or construction materials. A reminder that <u>Sand Road</u> accepts yard waste and brush for FREE.

Please note: Summer hours in the schedule below start on the May Long Weekend until Thanksgiving Weekend. However the Sno Drifters site will not commence its summer hours until May 25, 2021.
