WHEREAS Section 19 Suspension of Rules states that any procedure required by by-law 2015-024 being a by-law to govern the proceedings, conduct of members and calling of meeting of council and committees may be suspended with consent of a majority of the members of the council present.

AND WHEREAS the Province of Ontario declared an emergency under s. 7.0.1(1) of the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act on March 17, 2020;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Bonnechere Valley deems it expedient to suspend some of the rules stated in By-Law 2015-024 to allow for electronic participation;

NOW THERFORE the Council of the Township of Bonnechere Valley hereby enacts as follows:

1. The following sections of By-Law 2015-024 being a By-Law being a by-law to govern the proceedings, conduct of members and calling of meeting of council and committees are suspended and hereby amended by the following:

3(A) Meetings of Council shall be held by alternative means and posted online for the public to virtually attend to ensure transparency and accountability;

3(B) All meetings as defined in Section 1(g) shall only be open to the public by virtual means during emergencies declared locally or provincially under the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act but any meeting may be closed in part or in its entirety to the general public under Section 239 of the Municipal Act;

7 (j) It shall be the duty of the CAO or delegate to authenticate by signature or by stamping with the Mayor's signature stamp all By-Laws, resolutions and minutes of Council;

13. Delegations. Persons desiring to present information to Council will have to submit their presentations in writing by mail, email or municipal drop box to be read by the CAO, notice and time limit provisions under this section still apply;

14. (i) Every by-law enacted by Council shall be numbered, dated, and sealed with the corporate seal of the corporation and signed by the CAO and stamped with the Mayor's signature stamp and deposited by the CAO in her office for safekeeping.

- 2. The Mayor shall chair all electronically attended Council and Committee meetings.
- 3. In the absence of the Mayor Council will refer to Section 5 of By-Law 2015-024.
- 4. This Suspension of Rules shall come into full force and effect April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and shall remain in effect until May 30<sup>th</sup> 2020.
