RE: Masks Required in Indoor Public Facilities, Public Washrooms, Camp Fires, Operation Review Survey and Ask Mayor Murphy

Township of Bonnechere Valley – July 10, 2020 – The Renfrew County District Health Unit has advised us that face masks will be mandatory for our indoor public facilities commencing next week. If you do not have one when you visit one of our facilities, we will provide you with a disposable one and we also have reusable ones for sale at the office with proceeds going to support the Fire Department.

When you are out and about in the Village there are public washroom facilities that are available for use:

- Eganville Splash Pad Arena – 9 Foran Street – open from 10 am to 8 pm,
- McRae Park – 1713 Grist Mill Road – open from 8 am to 8 pm,
- Eganville Tourist Booth – 46 Bonnechere Street West – open from 8 am to 8 pm,
- Rotary Beach – 178B Jane Street – open from 8 am to 8 pm

Visitor information services are available at the Eganville Tourist Booth located on Highway 60. The tourist booth offers visitor information, public washrooms and picnic area.

Hours of operation for July to the end of August 2020 are CLOSED Monday & Tuesday and 10 am to 5 pm Wednesday to Sunday

Our area is in desperate need of some rain. The Bonnechere Valley Fire Department is encouraging residents to be extra cautious. Do not leave a camp fire unattended and make sure it is fully extinguished when you are done. Keep watch on the township's website should we need to reinstate a fire ban.
