 - iv. Closure of all outdoor recreational amenities and parks
 - v. Prohibiting events and gatherings of more than five people
 - vi. Closure of non-essential workplaces
 - vii. Work deployment for health service providers
 - viii. Work deployment for long-term care homes
 - ix. Prohibiting unfair pricing on necessary goods
 - x. Off-peak electricity pricing
 - xi. Drinking water and sewage
 - xii. Streamlining requirements for long-term care homes
 - xiii. Traffic management
 - xiv. Electronic service of documents
 - xv. Meetings for corporations
