Whereas the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic has increased the demand for suicide prevention services by 200%; and

Whereas existing suicide prevention hotlines require the user to remember a 10-digit number and to through directories or be placed on hold; and

Whereas in 2022 the United States will have in place a national 988 crisis hotline; and

Whereas the Township recognizes that it is a significant and important initiative to ensure critical barriers are removed to those in a crisis and seeking help;

Now therefore be it resolved that the Corporation of the Township of Bonnechere Valley endorses this 988 crisis line initiative;

And Further that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Honourable Vic Fedeli, MPP, Federal Minister of Health, Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications (CRTC) Commission and all municipalities in Renfrew County.
