## **NEW/UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

- (1)** Boardwalk Update, Bill Kennedy – Committee recommends that our engineers, Cambium Consulting and Engineering, do a peer review of the engineered drawings of the boardwalk projects. Bryan Martin to come back to Committee with the cost of the peer review. Brent Patrick will fundraise the \$9000 to cover the outstanding invoices, and if he is unable to cover the costs through his fundraising efforts, he will personally cover the cost;
- (2)** Firearms Ban – Tim Schison made a presentation to Committee on firearms.
