ENHANCED RECYCLING SYSTEM RESIDENTIAL & COMMERICAL - NEW

As of January 1st, 2026, Bonnechere Valley's recycling program will be managed by Circular Materials, a national not-for-profit organization that is committed to building an efficient and effective recycling system in Ontario. Right now, each Ontario community accepts different materials for recycling in different ways. Starting in 2026, recycling will become even simpler. Here's what's changing: Recycle anywhere: No matter where you are in the province - home, on vacation, or just passing through - you'll be able to recycle the same materials. Plus, you'll be able to recycle even more materials in your curbside recycling.
