### REDUCED LOAD LIMITS

Pursuant to By-Law 2012-009, reduced load limits will be strictly enforced on all Bonnechere Valley Township roads (except for the Village of Eganville). Effective March 1, 2025, to May 31st inclusive, or later if conditions warrant. Vehicle loads will be restricted to 5 tonnes per axle on all Bonnechere Valley Township roads where appropriate signs have been erected.
