2026 Municipal Election

VOTERS LIST

The Voters' List is the list of eligible electors in the Township of Bonnechere Valley. During an election cycle, Elections Ontario is responsible for preparing the preliminary list of electors for each municipality and school board in Ontario. Once a municipality has prepared the Voters' List, the Revision Period begins, and electors may add, amend or remove their voter information. For the purposes of the 2026 Municipal Elections, the Revision Period will take place from September 1, 2026, to September 20, 2026. Electors will also be able to check and update their voter information at the Township Office during regular business hours until October 23rd and at the Legion on October 26th.

VOTING METHODS

The vote by mail packages will be mailed out September 24th to every elector on the Voters List on the date of mailing. The envelopes can be returned to the Municipal Office up until October 23rd at 4pm. The last day to mail in your ballots is October 15th, 2026. Electors will also be able to vote at the Eganville Legion on October 26th 2026 from 10am to 8pm. The Ballots received by the Clerk after 8:00 PM on Voting Day shall not be counted and shall be treated as rejected ballots, placed in a sealed box and retained for the statutory document retention period.
