No waste cards are required at this time for any of the waste sites. **No garbage tags** are required for curbside pick-up or drop off at the waste sites.

On Friday, April 3, 2020, the government of Ontario gave notice of the changes to Ontario Regulation 82/20 (the "Order"), as a result of the outbreak of COVID-19. The changes reduce the number and type of construction activities deemed to be essential and limits residential construction to certain types of projects. The building department is moving forward with inspections for permits issued prior to April 4, 2020 for open air inspections. We request that nobody is on site for the enclosed indoor inspections for at least three days before the date of inspection. Applications are being accepted electronically and permits will continue to be issued. The issuance of Building Permits after April 5, 2020 however should not be construed as a statement that the construction of the building described in the permit is permitted as an essential business pursuant to the Order. All non-essential construction must be deferred until the government of Ontario has lifted the Order or enacted further changes to permit non-essential construction activities.
