**Reminder to Dog Owners**

Licensing your dog is their ticket home. It provides Animal & Bylaw Services with the information that is needed to reunite you with your dog.

Every calendar year, a new dog tag (license) must be obtained by March 31st.

Dog tags can be purchased for \$20 at the municipal office (49 Bonnechere Street East) from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm.



Purchasing your dog tag (license) after March 31st the fee increases to \$30.

**Time to Change your Clocks and the Batteries in all Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Alarms**

Clocks will fall back one hour at 2 am on March 14th and the Bonnechere Valley Fire Department is recommending residents install new batteries in their smoke and carbon monoxide alarms when they change their clocks.

In order to survive a fire, you need to be provided with an early warning and know what to do when the smoke alarm sounds. Working smoke alarms are required on every story of the home and outside all sleeping areas. For added protection, it is recommended to also install smoke alarms inside all bedrooms.

Carbon monoxide alarms must be installed outside all sleeping areas if your home has a fuel-burning appliance, fireplace or attached garage. Tampering with or removing the batteries from your smoke and carbon monoxide alarms is against the law. Failure to comply with the Fire Code can result in a ticket for \$360 or a fine of up to \$50,000.



**Reminder - Interim Tax Bill Time**

You will receive your Interim tax bill in the mail in the next couple of weeks. The installment due dates are: March 31st, 2021 and May 31st, 2021. If your property tax bill does not have the correct mailing address as specified by your postal carrier, it may not be delivered to you.

**Notice of Public Meeting**

In the matter of Section 34 of the Planning Act, the Township of Bonnechere Valley hereby gives NOTICE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- i) To amend Zoning By-law 2006-28 of the Township of Bonnechere Valley
- ii) A public meeting regarding an amendment to Zoning By-Law 2006-28 of the Township of Bonnechere Valley

**Subject Lands:** The By-Law affects all lands within the Township and therefore a key map is not provided.

**Public Meeting:** Continuation of the public meeting of the proposed zoning amendment will be held on **Friday, March 19, 2021 at 10 am**. This meeting will be by Zoom Conferencing and will be live streamed on the Township of Bonnechere Valley's Youtube Channel. The Zoom Meeting details will be posted on the Township of Bonnechere Valley's website by March 15, 2021. Submissions from individuals who have not previously submitted comments or those who have additional comments which are different from previous submissions will be accepted. Any comments not read at the February 16th meeting will also be included. Please email your comments to [danaj@eganville.com](mailto:danaj@eganville.com).

The purpose and effect of this application is to update the existing definitions for trailers and recreational vehicles. In addition the proposed zoning amendment would change the land use provisions of the Limited Service Residential – Exception One (LSR-E1), Limited Service Residential – Exception Two (LSR-E2), Rural Residential (RR), Rural (RU) and Residential Four (R4) Zones to permit a trailer/ recreational vehicle to be used for accommodation.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Township of Bonnechere Valley before the by-law is passed, by the Township, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Township of Bonnechere Valley, to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal.

NOTE: One of the purposes of the Planning Act is to provide for planning processes that are open accessible, timely and efficient. Accordingly, all written submissions, documents, correspondence, emails or other communications (including name and address) form part of the public record and will be disclosed/made available by the County/local Municipality to such persons as the County/local Municipality sees fit, including anyone requesting such information.
