Tax Department News

Just a reminder that the final installment for your 2021 taxes is due on October 29, 2021. Residents are encouraged to utilize online payment options. Tax and water bills can be paid online through your online banking services, through your financial institution.

Add Bonnechere Valley as a payee, use the search-term "Bonnechere Valley" and choose the appropriate "Taxes" for property taxes or "Water" for Water Utility billing. Your account number is your roll number and it can be found on your bill.

Taxes: Use your full roll number (account number) starting with 4738 - use all 19 digits of your roll number without any dashes or decimals. *If you own multiple properties you must set up each one as a separate account.

Water: Use your account number that is located on the top left hand side of your water bill - use all 14 digits of your account number - do not include any spaces.



Closures

The **Sand Road Waste Site** and the **Township of Bonnechere Valley's Municipal Office** will be **CLOSED** on **Monday, September 6, 2021** for Labour Day.

The **Sno Drifter's Waste Site** is **CLOSED** weekdays as of September 3, 2021. Beginning September 4, 2021 it is **OPEN Saturdays only**.

The **last day** to take **Household Hazardous Waste** to Sand Road will be on **October 9, 2021**. After this date the depot is **CLOSED** for the winter.

Special Leaf Pick-up for Village of Eganville residents will take place on **November 8, 2021**.
