#### **Interim Tax Bill Time**

You will receive your interim tax bill in the mail in the next couple of weeks. The installment due dates are: March 31, 2022 and May 31, 2022.

The final fax bill will be in the mail in August and will have installment due dates of August 31, 2022 and October 31, 2022

Residents are encouraged to utilize online payment options. Tax and water bills can be paid online through your online banking services, through your financial institution.

Add Bonnechere Valley as a payee, use the search-term "Bonnechere Valley" and choose the appropriate "Taxes" for property taxes or "Water" for Water Utility billing. Your account number is your roll and it can be found on your bill.



**Taxes:** Use your full roll number (account number) starting with 47387 - use all 19 digits of your roll number without any dashes or decimals. \*If you own multiple properties you must set up each one as a separate account.

**Water:** Use your account number that is located on the top left hand side of your water bill - use all 14 digits of your account number - do not include any spaces.

#### Comprehensive Zoning By-Law

Bonnechere Valley is in the process of updating the Township's comprehensive zoning by-law as required by the Planning Act. The update is Township wide and therefore every property has the potential to be affected.
